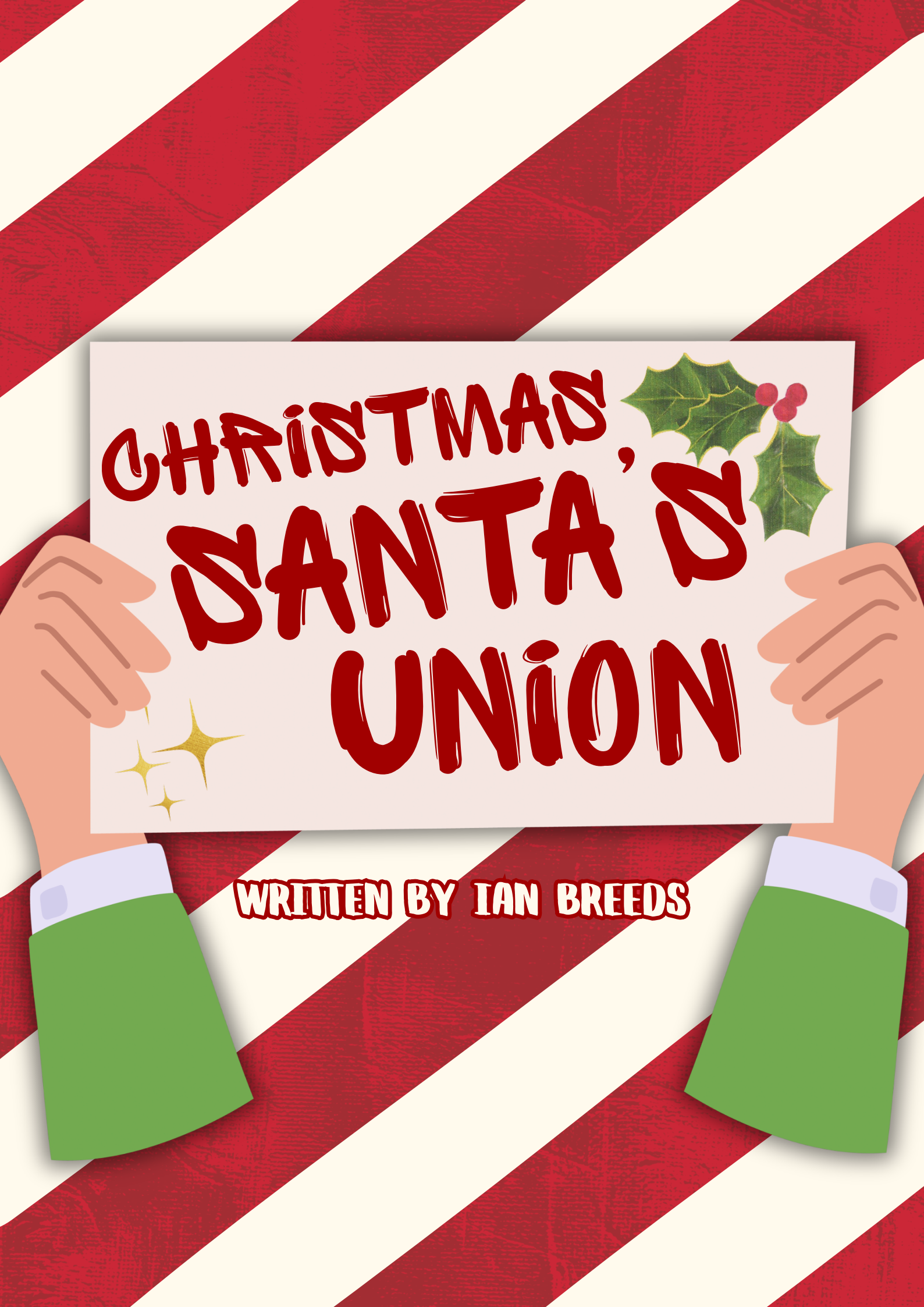

Synopsis

The Santa's quietly talk amongst themselves as Jackie and Alfie discuss the upcoming negotiations with headquarters. Jackie puts a tie on.

ALFIE
What are you doing?

JACKIE
I just want to look smart.

ALFIE
You always do this.

JACKIE
Do what?

ALFIE
Suck up to the boss. We're all wearing our Santa suits in solidarity, why do you have to stand out and make yourself look more important by wearing a tie?

JACKIE
It makes me feel the part, ready for negotiations with the union scum.

Everyone scowls at Jackie.

JACKIE
It was a joke. Keep your jingle bells on!

Talking can be heard coming from the hallway.

JACKIE
Here comes the corporate scum now!

ALFIE
Why would you scream that out loud?

Three elves (DAN, PAT & STEVIE) enter.

RICKIE
Are you lost? I can give you directions to a shelf.

DAN

PAT

Take it down a notch we're not here to start an argument.

PARKER

Then why are you here?

STEVIE

We want the same thing as you, equal rights.

All the Santa's start to laugh.

STEVIE

Sorry did I say something funny? I tell you what, tomorrow we'll go on strike and we'll see how you get on taking care of angry parents and annoying kids.

KYLE

Ok, let's all take a moment. The elves should have their say, whether we listen to it is another matter.

BLAKE

I feel they should stay, we are a team and there is no I in team but there is an I in selfish.

LOGAN
