10 Character Script

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To the side of a stage a party can be heard in full swing. On stage an office presides, decorated with an old Christmas tree and some tacky lights. The BOSS enters from the party and sits down at a desk, pulls out a bottle of alcohol and drinks it. The OFFICE GOSSIP enters.

OFFICE GOSSIP
Are we celebrating?

The boss chokes on the drink.

OFFICE GOSSIP
Sorry didn't mean to make you jump.

BOSS
You didn't. Enjoying the party?

OFFICE GOSSIP
You know me, love a good party. So the big meeting, I take it went well.

BOSS
You could say that. A deal was made. Please don't say anything to anyone.

OFFICE GOSSIP
My lips are sealed, I'm sure you want to announce the big news to everyone yourself.

BOSS
I'm going to have to. Here, for you.

The boss hands Office Gossip the bottle.

OFFICE GOSSIP
Don't mind if I do, Merry Christmas.

BOSS
Yes.

The Boss exits. The Gossip gets her phone out and starts texting.

Enter INTERN 1 & SECRETARY.

SECRETARY
Trying to score some bonus points with the Boss?

OFFICE GOSSIP

You're just jealous because I'm her
number one.

SECRETARY

Yeah right.

OFFICE GOSSIP

Did she tell you how the meeting
went?... Didn't think so.

Exit Gossip

SECRETARY

I can't stand her.

INTERN 1

At least you don't have to work in their
department. I really don't think she
even knows I exist.

SECRETARY

My poor little pigeon, I don't think
anyone apart from me knows you
exist here.

Enter Flashy

INTERN 1

Oh great this should be fun.

FLASHY

Pigeon!

INTERN 1

(TO SECRETARY)

Did you start this?

FLASHY

Start what?

SECRETARY

I didn't.

INTERN 1

I don't want to be known as pigeon.

FLASHY

Then stop being a scared scatty little
bird and I might remember your name.
